Thank you to the more than 4,000 community members who attended the recent Joshua Falls to Yeat Electric Transmission Line Project open houses. Your feedback, both in person and online, is helping to shape this project and is greatly appreciated.

The Joshua Falls to Yeat Project proposes construction of an approximately 115-mile, 765 kV electric transmission line connecting the existing Joshua Falls Substation in Campbell County, Virginia to a proposed new substation in Culpeper County, Virginia.

This transmission line is needed as Virginia's electricity demand continues to grow. It will support grid reliability, economic competitiveness and energy security, while also creating jobs and boosting local economies during construction.

We are still early in the process of adjusting the routes based on your feedback. We'll share the updated routes with the public at our next round of open house meetings in June.
